CAPABILITIES

CMC

ARCINOVA are continuing to invest in their analytical capabilities and have recently purchased and installed an updated console for their Bruker 500 MHz NMR. This investment will enhance the solution state and solid state data acquisition and processing capabilities for this key instrument.

API

Installation of the 20L streams is now imminent and will be fully validated by the end of July 2017. In order to facilitate API development, plans to install new bulk chromatography and a Uniqsis FlowSyn™ continuous flow reactor been submitted. The addition will enable Arcinova to develop and simplify the scale-up of a challenging API batch process.
